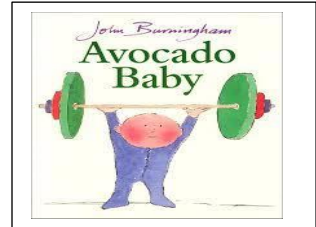
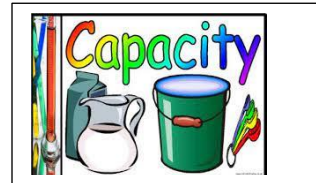


We have planned some very exciting learning for our last half term in Year 1.

In English, we are writing our own defeating tales based on the story 'Avocado Baby'. We will also be writing rhyming poems about summer and writing a non-fiction leaflet about healthy eating.



In Maths we will be learning how to do addition and subtraction up to 100. We will also be learning about money, including solving word problems. We will be beginning to multiply and divide and measuring using capacity and volume.



In Science we are continuing our learning about plants. We will look at the parts of plants, how plants grow and planting our own seeds. We will also be finding out about the season of Summer.



In DT we will be designing and making our own greenhouses and terrariums to plant sunflower seeds in.



In Art we will be participating in creative activities to help us prepare for moving up to our new class during Transition Week.

READING TO SUPPORT OUR LEARNING:

Practise reading every night at home. Sign your child's reading record so they can move up on the reading chart.

Ask your child questions on what they have read. Talk about the characters and the setting of the story.
