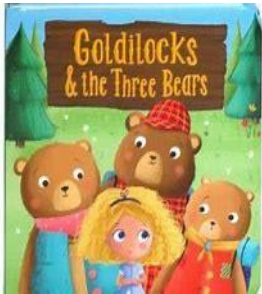


In Nursery, our main topic will be **Traditional Tales**. These will include:



In **Literacy**, we will be learning to tell the stories, dressing up and acting them out, and talking about and describing the different characters.

In **Maths**, we will be learning to count, recognise numbers, and match numbers to quantities. We will also be learning about different sizes, small, medium and large.

We will make porridge, and gingerbread men, and build houses with different materials to see which is strongest.

We will also be celebrating Chinese New Year, and doing lots of crafts such as making dragons and lanterns to learn about this.

### READING TO SUPPORT OUR LEARNING:

Read your child's SABAH book with them every night.

Retell traditional Tales with them, encouraging them to join in with the phrases – e.g. " I'll huff, and I'll puff..."

Talk about the characters in stories , e.g. the Big Bad Wolf!



### WHAT YOU CAN DO AT HOME TO SUPPORT THE LEARNING:

Use the language of size, e.g. sorting things like clothes and food packaging into different sizes (large medium, small)

Play games where your child has to roll a dice, and count the spots.

Point out numbers in the environment when you are out and about.
