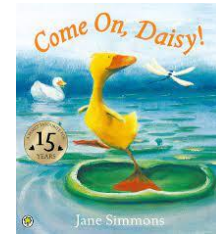
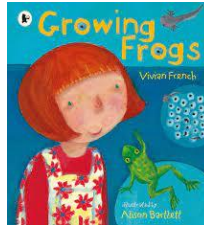
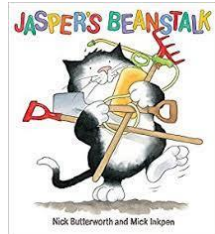
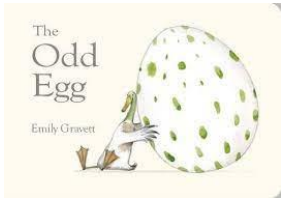


In Nursery, our main topic will be **Spring**, and in this topic we will be focussing on growth and lifecycles of animals and plants. Some of the books we will be reading are: Come on Daisy, The Odd Egg, Jasper's Beanstalk and Growing Frogs.



In **Literacy**, we will be learning about the beginning middle and end of stories. We are also going to try The Helicopter Technique, where the children make up a story and act it out on a stage. We will be practicing writing our names and looking for words in the environment.

In **Maths**, we will be learning to recognise and name 2D shapes, as well as looking for them in the environment. We will continue learning to count and recognise numbers and begin to look at solving number problems.

We will be getting some super special visitors arriving in week 2: **DUCKLINGS!** We will learn all about their lifecycle and how to care for them.



WHAT YOU CAN DO AT HOME TO SUPPORT THE ENGLISH LEARNING:

Read your child's SABAH book with them every night.

Talk about what happens at the beginning, the middle and the end of the story.

Ask your child to make predictions about what they think will happen next or at the end of the story.

Look for words together in the environment at home or when out at the shops.

Ask your child to practice writing their name. Remember to only use upper case for the first letter.



WHAT YOU CAN DO AT HOME TO SUPPORT THE MATHS LEARNING:

Point out numbers in the environment at home or when walking to school. Practice naming them with your child.

Point out shapes in the environment at home or when walking to school. Practice naming them and talking about how many sides and corners they have.

Practice counting with your child, it can be anything! The plates for dinner or the apples you bought at the shop.
