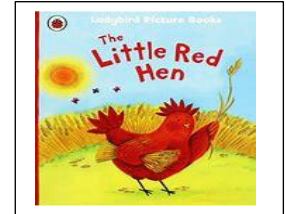


We have planned a very exciting half term in Reception.

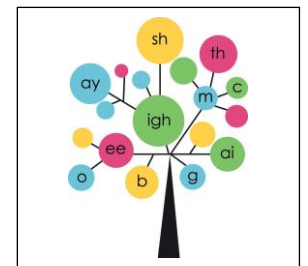
Literacy – This half term our Literacy learning will be centred around our heritage, the community we live in and citizenship. We will be looking at the places we live and the differences in our community, We will also be looking at ourselves and discussing why we are special and looking at some of the things in our past that we have celebrated such as birthdays, Eid and Christmas. We will be looking at the traditional tale of The Little Red Hen and the celebration on Chinese New Year.



Maths – This half-term we will be enhancing our learning and understanding of numbers within 15 and grasping addition and subtraction within these numbers. We will also be looking at how we group objects in different ways e.g. colour, shape or size. The children will be using a range of manipulates such as cubes, shapes and counters to help them be confident maths learners.



Phonics– This half term the children will be moving on to phase 3 and will be learning more advanced techniques and strategies to become confident in reading and writing, The children will continue to practice their skills and knowledge with daily lessons and activities to spark their interest. The children will continue to learn tricky and high frequency words to support their ability to read and write.



What you can do at home to support your child's learning:

Here are some areas to practice with your child at home:

- Practice saying the sound that each letter makes. Example: 'S' makes the 'sss' sound.
