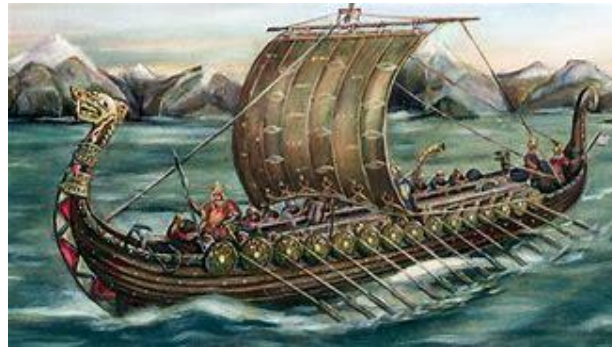


IN SPRING A WE WILL BE LEARNING:

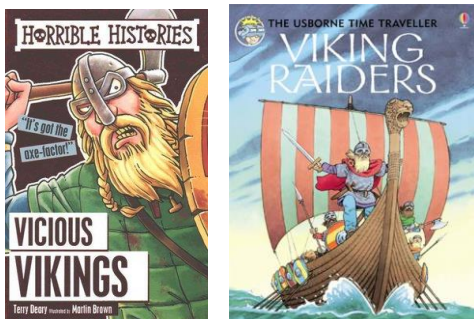
This half term we will be studying The Vikings in our History lessons: were they vicious or victorious? We will look at what life was like in Britain during this time. Our English fiction and non-fiction units will also link with our History topic. We will be writing flashback stories and a non-chronological report about Viking weapons.



During Maths we will be continuing our work on calculation, including missing number problems and algebra. Later in the term, we will study angles, coordinates and shape. We will also be focusing heavily on strengthening our Arithmetic skills.

Our Science learning will be focused on Light. We will be looking at how different colours of light can be created, and exploring a range of phenomena such as rainbows, colours and soap bubbles.
