

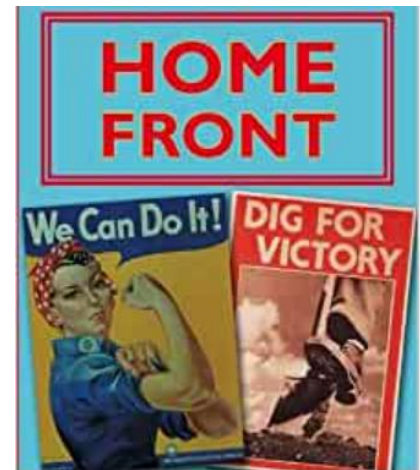
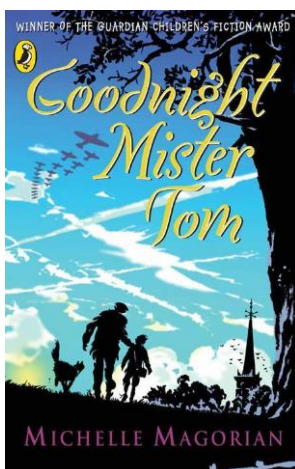
IN SPRING B WE WILL BE LEARNING:

This half term we will be studying World War Two in our History lessons as part of the whole school theme – Travelling through Time. We will look at what life was like in Britain during this time and read and research widely about the Homefront, Evacuation, Rationing and Women’s roles during the war. Our English units will also link with our History topic; we will be writing formal persuasive explanation leaflets about ‘How to be a Homefront Hero’ and also more informal letters. Our Guided Reading will be around ‘Goodnight Mr. Tom’ to link and further the knowledge and vocabulary needed to write on the subject of the war.

During Maths we will be working on measure—making links to the wartime rations and converting units of measure and statistics.

Our Art work will also be linked to our topic of World War 2.

In Science we will be looking at Humans – the digestive, respiratory and circulatory systems.

**READING TO SUPPORT OUR LEARNING:****WHAT YOU CAN DO AT HOME TO SUPPORT THE LEARNING:**

- Read with your child every day. This will increase their vocabulary and familiarise them with a wide range of genres.
