


Welcome back to the new school year! We are happy to be back and this half term we are going to be focusing on our wellbeing and settling back in to routines.

In English we will be looking at the story 'Scaredy Squirrel' as well as learning about poetry and reading stories from other cultures. Our focus will be on verbal retelling and sequencing and working on sentence structure and letter formation.



In Maths we will be working with numbers within 10. We will be working on number recognition, ordering numbers and addition and subtraction. We will also be learning about shape and pattern.



In Science we are looking at different animals and how to sort them into different groups (classifying) depending on their features.



Our project work this half term is all about PSHE and looking at team work, new beginnings, cooperation, developing classroom skills and making good choices.



READING TO SUPPORT OUR LEARNING:

You can login to your child's MyON account where children can go and read books online.

To get started, just go to www.myon.co.uk/login/ and enter those login details. Once you have logged in, just click on the library tab and your child can start reading away! There is also an audio option so your child can listen to the book being read to them and they can have a go at following the text and joining in where they can.

Ask your child questions on what they have read or stories they have heard.



WHAT YOU CAN DO AT HOME TO SUPPORT OUR LEARNING:

Regularly practise of counting and ordering numbers up to 20

Practise saying one more and one less than a number up to 20.

Practise writing the year 1 keywords and using the phonic mat to spell words.
