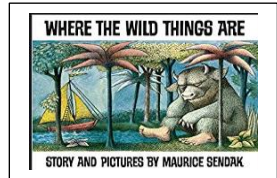
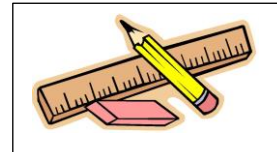


We have planned a very exciting half term in Year 1.

In English, we are going to be writing their own portal tale based on the story 'Where the wild things are. We will also be writing a diary entry of the character of the book and a recount of events.



In Maths we will be learning about how to measure using scales and other equipment. We will also be learning about fractions and continuing to add and subtract using problems.

READING TO SUPPORT OUR LEARNING:

Practise reading every night at home. Sign your child's reading record so they can move up on the reading chart.

Ask your child questions on what they have read. Talk about the characters and the setting of the story.



Take your child to a library and allow them to bring home any books they are interested in. Encourage them to read every night before bed.

Practise writing the year 1 keywords and using the phonic mat to spell words.
