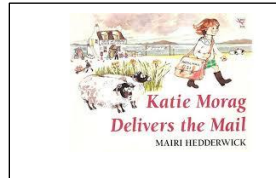


## We have planned a very exciting half term in Year 1.

### WHAT YOU CAN DO AT HOME TO SUPPORT OUR LEARNING:

Regularly practise of all the number bonds to 5,6,7,8 and 10.

Learning to tell the time - using a clock and half past.

Practise writing the year 1 keywords and using the phonic mat to spell words.
