


Welcome back to the new school Term! Hope you had a good Christmas break and New Year.

We are looking forward to lots of exciting learning this term

In English we will be looking at the story 'Dogger' and writing our own losing tale. Our focus will be on creating a wanted poster. We will be looking at some cross curricular writing through instructions of a moving toy



In Maths we will be working with numbers within 50. We will be exploring calculation strategies with 20. We will also be learning about time



In Science we are continuing our unit on materials. We will be looking at properties of everyday objects and materials. The children will be sorting materials in a given criteria and investigating which material is the best for an umbrella for a teddy.



Our project work this half term is looking at difference between life for children in the past and life now. We will be comparing toys from the past and present day. Understanding how schools were different in Victorian times to how they are now. We will be making our own puppets in DT.



## READING TO SUPPORT OUR LEARNING:

You can login to your child's MyON account where children can go and read books online.
