


IN AUTUMN B WE WILL BE LEARNING:

Geography

We will be focusing on comparing Manchester to Pakistan, locating Pakistan on a world map and learning positional language. The children will have lots of opportunities to look at world maps and look at the human and physical features of Manchester and Pakistan.





Maths, English and Science

We will then be learning all about poetry and then our final weeks of we will be writing a set of instructions of 'How to get to Grandma's house' which links with the Little Charlie story.



In Maths we will be learning how to solve addition and subtraction word problems, read and interpret graphs, learn how to measure length and multiply by 2, 5 and 10.

In Science we will be learning all about living things and their habitats. The children will have opportunities to compare living things and their habitats. We will also be looking at the basic needs of animals and how their habitats provide them with their basic needs.
