


IN SPRING B WE WILL BE LEARNING:

History

We are going to be Historians learning about Florence Nightingale. We will be looking into Florence's life and why she became a nurse. The children will be looking into the changes of hospitals over time and how hospitals have improved to the ones we have in the present day.



Maths and English

The story we will be reading in English is Jack and the Beanstalk which links with our Science topic of plants. We will be using our knowledge of appropriate adjectives to describe settings and characters. We will then look at some alternative endings and compare Jack and the Beanstalk to Maximus and the Beanstalk which is closely linked with the original story. We will be focusing on generating new vocabulary, expanded noun phrases and suffixes.

In Maths the children will be looking at how to tell the time using an analogue and a digit clock. We will then look at money and addition and subtraction with regrouping and adjusting.

Science

The children will be learning all about plants. We will learn what plants need to survive, observe bulbs growing into plants and find out how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow.


READING TO SUPPORT OUR LEARNING:

Looking at any traditional tales linked to Jack and the Beanstalk even if they are a different version of the story.

Any books or information about Florence Nightingale.

Reading non-fiction books about plants or what plants need to survive.

WHAT YOU CAN DO AT HOME TO SUPPORT THE LEARNING:



You can focus on telling the time looking at o'clock, half past, Quarter past and quarter. Ask your child what time it is during the day.

When you go shopping ask your child about what change they think you will receive at the shop. If you are buying more than one item can they add the amounts together?

Keep reminding children about their times tables. Focus on 2, 5, 10 and 3.
