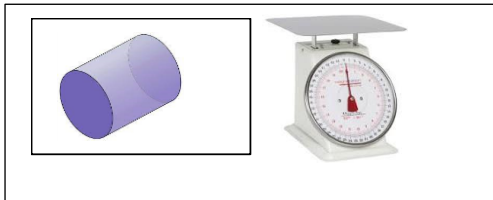
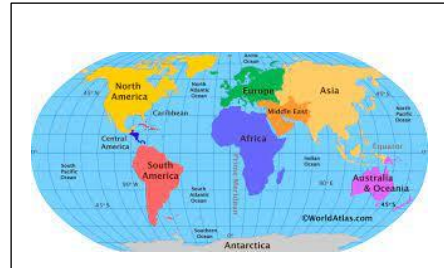


## IN SUMMER A WE WILL BE LEARNING:

### Geography

This half term we will be having weekly themes including Our World and Beyond and Orienteering and Map Skills. We will be looking at the world map and locating the worlds continents and oceans as well as looking at physical features of places around the United Kingdom.



### Maths and English

This half term we will be giving the children many writing opportunities and looking at a wider range of punctuation and spellings in a variety of texts. We will be reading stories such as Miki, The Healthy Wolf and The Day the Crayons Quit.

In Maths we will be revisiting addition and subtraction and will learn how to adject and exchange. We will then learn all about 2D and 2D shapes and positional language. After that we will weigh items in mass.

### Science

This half term we will learning about animals including humans. We will be looking at the basic needs of a variety of humans and other animals.



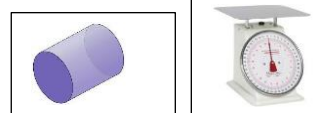
## READING TO SUPPORT OUR LEARNING:

Reading a variety of stories including traditional tales to enhance the childrens language and vocabulary.

Information books about animals and humans.

Information books about countries and cities around the world.

## WHAT YOU CAN DO AT HOME TO SUPPORT THE LEARNING:



You can focus on addition and subtraction without exchange. For example  $22 + 13 =$  . Use scales to measure mass when cooking.

Discuss the shapes and features of everyday objects. E.g. A tin of beans is a cylinder it has 3 faces, 2 edges and 0 vertices (corner).

Keep reminding children about their times tables. Focus on 2, 5, 10 and 3.
