

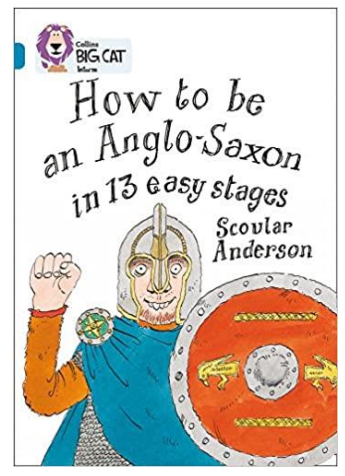
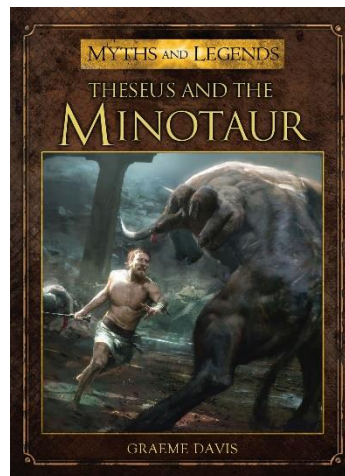
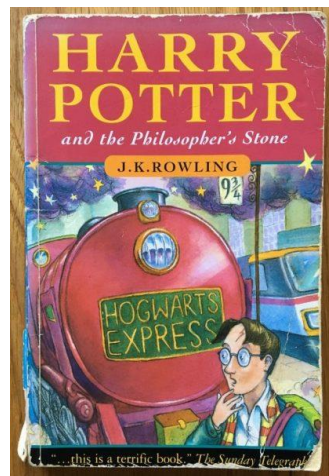
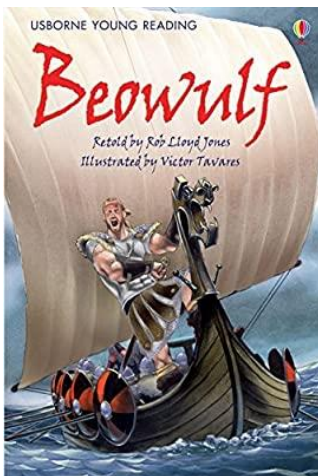
### IN SPRING A WE WILL BE LEARNING:

In English we are writing a defeating the monster tale similar to the famous myth of Beowulf and writing a non-chronological report on the Anglo-Saxons.

In Science we will be continuing our about materials and their properties and will be carrying out investigations to develop our 'working scientifically skills'.

In Maths we will be learning formal written methods for multiplication and division, which is why we have been working so hard lately to revise times tables, including multiples and factors.
