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### Year 6 Update

Currently the children have completed test papers in school to provide a baseline (starting point) to complete a question level analysis which will identify specific gaps in the children's knowledge. From this we will set up interventions to teach these gaps from Autumn B. We are doing everything we can to support your children through this difficult time, which is why we have invested money in the CGP books and individual i-pads for this year group.

### What are SATs (in the UK)?

The SATs are a series of standardised assessments for Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2 pupils, aimed at testing their learning progress.

### When are the KS2 SATs 2021?

The 2021 KS2 SATs take place between Monday 10<sup>th</sup> May and Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> May.

### Timetable

An example timetable:

- Monday May 10<sup>th</sup> 2021: Spelling, punctuation and grammar (Grammar/Punctuation Test) - 45 minutes
- Monday May 10<sup>th</sup> 2021: Spelling, punctuation and grammar (Spelling Test) - 20 minutes
- Tuesday May 11<sup>th</sup> 2021: Reading Test - 60 minutes
- Wednesday May 12<sup>th</sup> 2021: Maths Paper 1 (Arithmetic) - 30 minutes
- Wednesday May 12<sup>th</sup> 2021: Maths Paper 2 (Reasoning) - 40 minutes
- Thursday May 13<sup>th</sup> 2021: Maths Paper 3 (Reasoning) - 40 minutes

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*At KS2 there is also a 'Writing' component to the SATs, but this is teacher-assessed and moderated.*

### **Government Guidance regarding Eid**

*'In 2021, Eid is due to begin on the evening of Wednesday 12 May. We understand that, given the significance of Eid, Muslim pupils may be absent from school.*

*Schools may use timetable variations to reschedule the mathematics test for pupils who will be absent for Eid. If large numbers of pupils are absent, schools may decide it is appropriate to delay the test for the whole cohort.'*

*As a school we will be reading the timetable variation guidance from the government, which will be updated in December 2020 to revise the timetable to accommodate for this. We will provide more information to parents once this has finalised.*

*On the website we have put parent/carer SATs guides for each of the areas the children are being tested in to help you understand the types of questions they will come across and some tips to help them with their subject knowledge.*
