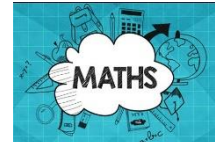

Maths Battle!

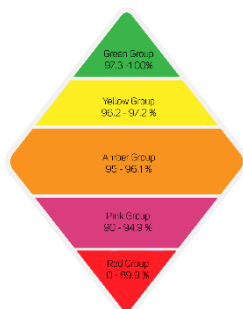

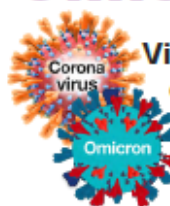
